Position(s): Adult Canoe Kayak (Masters) Coordinator

The ACK (Masters) Coordinator will lead the planning and delivery of safe, fun, and athlete development appropriate programs for CPCC's Adult Sprint Canoe/Kayak program participants. The program will host two coached sessions per week and programming for CPCC's General Membership open hours.

Responsibilities:

- Lead the planning and implementation of all CPCC Masters program for paddlers 25+
- Collaborate with the Head Coach and management team to develop and implement creative, innovative, and effective seasonal and weekly program plans
- Communicate professionally with participants and the CPCC management team (welcome email, regular updates, replying to program inquiries, telephone communications, etc.)
- Collaborate with management and the CPCC coaching team to ensure program equipment and facilities are clean and in good working condition
- Attend all Master's program training sessions and competitions, and assess program and participants regularly
- Attend all club hosted events, including Master's regattas and club social events
- Coordinate with Head Coach and coaching team to complete all Master's program related regatta entries
- Ensure member compliance with club safety standards and CPCC Code of Conduct
- Participate in weekly staff meetings as needed
- Complete a season-end program review
