**Position: Dock Duty**

Dock Duty staff will be responsible for setting up the club facility and equipment before membership hours, monitoring members during open hours, and ensuring a safe environment for members and staff.

**Duties:**

- Set-up equipment and facility to ensure a safe environment for members and staff during open hours
- Ensure members are screened and signed in to use club equipment during open hours
- Monitor participants during open hours and ensure all members and equipment return safely to the clubhouse on time
- Enforce membership rules and policies during working hours
- Ensure program equipment and facility is clean and in good working order
- Complete club closure procedures at the end of each working shift
- Ensure participant compliance with club safety standards and CPCC Codes of Conduct

- NCCP Community Coach Trained (can be completed once application has been accepted)
- Pleasure Craft Operators license
- Proven Leadership, organizational, and communication skills
- Standard First Aid & CPR-C
- Safe Sport Trained and Screened
